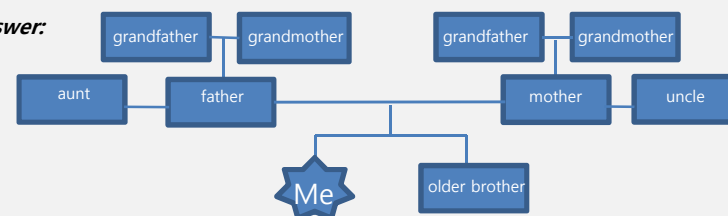
Example.
